

Dear Families,

Your child's birthday is a special occasion, and we will be happy to celebrate it in school. We celebrate each child's birthday the Montessori way through the Celebration of Life. This is for your child and their classmates only. However, we will record each Celebration of Life, and send it to you, so you may review the celebration through pictures and videos. Please complete the Celebration of Life form and submit it to your child's teacher. You can send in the photographs of your child a day before their birthday/birthday celebration.

We know in addition to the Celebration of Life many parents would like to send in a small treat to also celebrate your child's birthday. If you would like to do this please send in the attached form to your child's teacher 7 days in advance of the celebration. Whatever is brought in to celebrate must also be individually portioned and peanut free, we do not allow sheet cakes. You may send in goody bags as long as they do not contain any food, candy or any small choking hazards.

Many families may also choose to have a celebration outside of school. We can help distribute hard copied invitations. They must be handed to the teacher to distribute, we do this so that if you are not inviting the whole class to the party children's feelings get hurt. We will not send out reminders or be responsible for RSVP's.

Birthday Celebration Guidelines

- We ask that you please provide a list of ingredients with each food item that is brought into the classroom. Remember we are a Peanut Aware School so we do not allow Peanut Products in our schools.
- You can provide a juice box or small bottled water to accompany the snack you are providing.
- You must also include dessert plates and napkins.
- Balloons are not allowed, but you can bring in one candle.
- Goodie bags are permitted they may not contain any food, candy or small choking items.
 Some suggestions are books, art supplies and/or reusable water bottles.
